## Silver Singalong

Silver Singalong is a ground-up initiative founded by William Ang. The group comprises seniors who bonded over their love of music. The group of seniors goes to places with free to use pianos in Singapore to perform for about an hour to bring cheer to people. There are currently around 50 senior members in Silver Singalong.

Silver Singalong performs around six regular monthly performances with TTSH, Changi General Hospital, Voices of Hope dementia patients and several Ren Ci nursing homes. At Ren Ci, a small group of 3 will spend an hour going from ward to ward to sing and take song requests from patients which include palliative patients.

The Resonance Project was started in 2021 by Elijah Chao and Ivan Chiew. Their mission is to reach out to the beneficiaries, providing an activity and a platform for interaction with the youth volunteers and foster a culture of care for others (beneficiaries) and among the youth themselves.
