A practitioner- oriented programme held over five days, TFLUGP explores the following key themes:

- Resilient and sustainable environment
- Competitive economy

Participants at this year's session will delve into topics such as health, transport, housing, water management and the sustainable financing of cities. Through site visits, they will also get to experience first-hand the implementation of urban solutions, for example, the revitalisation of the Singapore River, development of new towns, and waste management.

Notable speakers and lecturers in the programme include the movers and shakers of Singapore's urban development, such as Dr Liu Thai Ker, former Chief Planner and Chief Executive Officer, Urban Redevelopment Authority, Dr Cheong Koon Hean, former Chief Executive Officer, Housing and Development Board, Professor Neo Boon Siong, Canon Chair Professor of Business, Nanyang Technological University, and Ms Low Sin Leng, Senior Adviser, Sembcorp Development Pte Ltd.
